## Dear Parishioners,

The diaconate is an ancient order of the Church reinstituted as a permanent office by Pope Paul VI at the suggestion of the Second Vatican Council (1963-1965). While every priest is ordained a deacon as a step towards ordination to the priesthood, ordination to the diaconate does not have to be transitory, that is, a step towards priesthood. Some men are ordained to the permanent diaconate and serve as deacons for the rest of their lives.

Because they are not on the way to priesthood, deacons are permitted to marry. A married deacon's primary responsibility remains his commitment to his wife and family. For this reason, the wives of married deacons are asked to participate in the process of preparation and be supportive of their husband's ministry once ordained.

Deacons are men who love God and love the Church yet feel called to serve in a more committed way. The role of the deacon is to be a helper of the bishops and priests. Specifically, deacons are called to preach the Gospel, serve the needs of the Church (the word "deacon" means "servant" or "helper"), and assist at the celebration of Liturgies.

Six months ago, Bishop Tobin announced his intention to recruit, train and ordain a new class of Permanent Deacons for our Diocese (the first class since 1997). Sixty-four men applied for a spot in the new class. After rigorous evaluation, twenty-four men were accepted. Of the twentyfour men, two are from our parish: Mr. John Fulton and Mr. Kenneth Andrade. I wish to extend my sincere congratulations to John (and his wife, Anna, and family) and to Ken (and his wife, Helen, and family) on acceptance into the new deacon class. They are exceptional candidates who would serve the Church very well. As a parish, we should be very proud to have two candidates for the permanent diaconate. That is certainly a sign of the strong faith of our parish community. I ask you to pray for John and Ken. These next four years of preparation for them are a time of study, prayer and discernment of God's call. Please God, they will persevere to ordination in 2013!

On a sad note, we mark this Thursday, January 22<sup>nd</sup>, the 36<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Roe v. Wade decision which legalized abortion in our nation. How this destruction of innocent human life continues, I do not understand. Nevertheless, our obligation continues to do all in our power to overturn this work of the Evil One which insults the Creator of all life. Please, please pray for an end to abortion. A Catholic true to his or her faith should do no less. God bless you in the week ahead.


# PRO-LIFE RALLY
