Dear Parishioners,

On Tuesday, February 15th, Bishop Tobin will lead an evening of prayer and reflection for high school and college young men who have thought about a vocation to the Priesthood. As you know, there is a painful shortage of priests today—but there doesn’t need to be! God is calling young men to serve His people as priests (maybe even in your own homes!) Unfortunately, our noisy world makes it hard to hear the voice of God. Worse, many people don’t see the value in becoming a priest at all.

So why should a man become a priest? I’ll give you seven reasons:

- 1) The world needs heroes.
- 2) The world needs the Eucharist.
- 3) We need our sins forgiven.
- 4) We need to hear God’s truth.
- 5) We need to know God loves us.
- 6) Because God asked.
- 7) Because good priests make a huge difference.

Being a priest is counter-cultural—it always has been. That’s why men are drawn to it. Being a priest is a challenge—something that requires blood, sweat and sacrifice. And deep inside, men love a challenge.

We need to awaken that desire for a challenge inside our young men. Priesthood is not an easy life—but it is an amazing life!! To bring Jesus to others and to lead others to Jesus—is there anything more important??

If you know anyone who might have a vocation to the Priesthood, nourish that vocation, pray for that vocation. Ask him to speak to his parish priest or our Assistant Vocations Director, Fr. The Priesthood is an unbelievable adventure—I wouldn’t trade it for anything in this world!! God bless you in the week ahead.

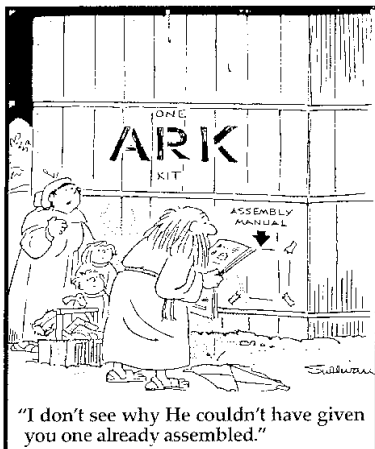
