*Dear Parishioners,*

If you open a newspaper, turn on the TV or browse the internet, you will see how far our society has fallen from its Christian foundations: increased violence, broken relationships, corruption and greed seem to be everywhere. While experts have been trying to determine the causes, the problem is very simple: humanity has forgotten who we are, why we are here and what our ultimate purpose is.

Pope John Paul II gave a series of talks (129 in total) from 1979 – 1984 to address these very questions. These talks have come to be called his “Theology of the Body” (TOB). TOB is an exciting and profound insight into our human condition: our identity (as male and female; body and soul), our relationship to one another and to God, and our path to ultimate happiness in this world and the next. What is so powerful about TOB is that Pope John Paul II shows how the Church’s teachings fit perfectly with our own personal experiences of life. As he writes, his words resonate within our hearts, no matter who we are or where we are in life.

I believe this “Theology of the Body” will one day transform the Church and the world! It brings together 2,000 years of Church teaching and experience into a beautiful, integrated and fulfilling understanding of the human person and our great dignity. TOB is a message of hope in our broken and confused world for everyone: married, single, consecrated, divorced or widowed.

I will be offering an introductory seminar on this “Theology of the Body” during Lent (see inside the bulletin for more details). I hope that many of you will consider coming on this journey with me. I promise you will not be disappointed.

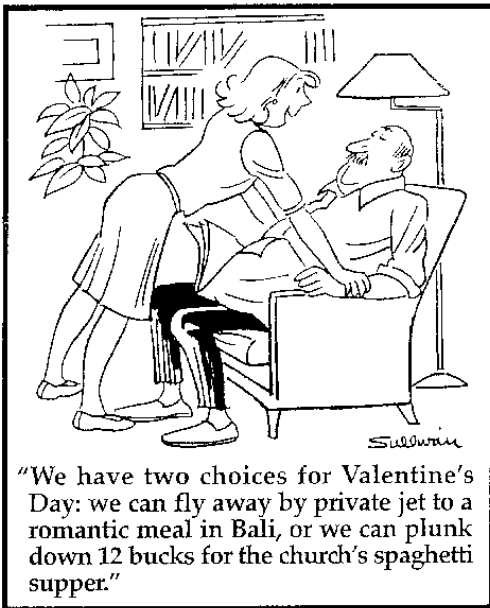
