In the spirit of this weekend's Gospel, I would like to share with you a handwritten sign found on the wall of Blessed Mother Teresa's room in Calcutta:

- People are often unreasonable, illogical, and self-centered; forgive them anyway.
- If you are kind, people may accuse you of selfish, ulterior motives; be kind anyway.
- If you are successful, you will win some false friends and some true enemies; be successful anyway.
- If you are honest and frank, people may cheat you; be honest and frank anyway.
- What you spend years building, someone could destroy overnight; build anyway.
- If you find serenity and happiness, others may be jealous; be happy anyway.
- The good you do today, people will forget tomorrow; do good anyway.
- Give the world the best you have, and it may never be enough; give your best anyway.
- For you see, in the final analysis, it is between you and God. It was never between you and them anyway.

Mother Teresa changed the world because she lived these words. Despite all her selfless, hard work for the poor, she had many detractors, nay-sayers, critics and even enemies. She loved them all and united the sufferings they caused her to the sufferings of Christ and accomplished miracles. It's the same for us.
