This week we enter the holy season of Lent—those sacred 40 days where we step back, look at our sins (how they hurt us and others) and seek to deepen our connection with Jesus, who heals and transforms our hearts and desires. Here at our parish, we have plenty of opportunities to grow in grace.

On Ash Wednesday, we will admit to ourselves and the world that we are sinners by the ashes on our foreheads. Masses for Ash Wednesday will be at 7:00 AM, 12 Noon, 2:30 PM (at West Bay Manor), 5:00 PM and 7:00 PM.

On Sunday, April 10th – Wednesday, April 13th we will have our Parish Mission. Our Mission preacher is Fr. Wade Menezes, CPM. Fr. Menezes is a gifted preacher who offers Missions throughout the United States and around the world. We are truly blessed to have him as our Mission preacher this year (please spread the word!). Our Mission will include a Holy Hour on Sunday and Monday, a Penance Service on Tuesday and a Healing Mass (with the Anointing of the Sick) on Wednesday. I hope you can join us this year for what will certainly be an amazing Mission!

Stations of the Cross with Benediction will be held on Fridays at 7:00 PM ("Living Stations" on Friday, April 8th at 7:30 PM with the eighth grade students at St. Rose of Lima School and our parish choir).

Rice Bowls are available at the doors. Please take one and fill it with "alms" for the poorest of our world. Rice Bowl donations will be collected on Palm Sunday.

Finally, Daily Mass continues at 7:00 AM Monday to Friday. Daily Mass is the <u>BEST</u> way to jump start your day—the benefits are truly amazing (ask any of our daily Mass-goers!!!). May you have a peaceful and holy Lent. Please be assured of my prayers for you throughout this blessed season.

Next Sunday at 2:00 PM, our second grade students will make their First Confession. They're a little nervous, but not like when we were children! Please say a prayer for them—and make a promise to yourself that you will make a good Confession this Lent (even if you haven't been in decades!). You'll be surprised at how much peace this powerful sacrament offers. God bless you in the week ahead.

<u>Lenten Fast and Abstinence Regulations</u>

Church law requires abstinence from meat (for those 14 and older) on Ash Wednesday and the Fridays of Lent. In addition, Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are fast days: those between the ages of 18 and 59 should eat less, that is take no solid foods between meals and only one meal that day should be a full one. If a medical condition prevents a person from fasting, then another sacrifice may be substituted.
