Two weeks ago, I received over a hundred handmade birthday cards from the students of St. Rose School. They were wonderful to read! One student wrote this, “Dear Father Wilson, I hope you have a good birthday. Don’t think of getting a year older. Think of getting another year **HOLIER.**” What a beautiful spiritual insight! May we all celebrate our birthdays each year with the hope of growing another year holier!

Next weekend, our minds and hearts turn to the annual Catholic Charity Fund Appeal. The Charity Appeal is the largest fundraiser for the needy in our state. The good this appeal does is truly remarkable thanks to the generosity of so many Catholics throughout our diocese. Thousands of people—the young, the elderly, the sick, the struggling—benefit from your annual donation!

We will hold our in-pew solicitation for the Charity Appeal at all the Masses **NEXT** weekend, March 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup>, and the weekend of March 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup>. Our goal this year is the same as last year \$95,000 (we raised \$102,000 last year). I have again enrolled us in the “Parish Share” program. Any amount over our goal will be returned to us and deposited in our Fr. Ferry Endowment Fund (this year our Fr. Ferry Fund awarded over \$7,000 in financial aid to students in our school).

While our economy is a little better, it is still not out of the woods. And the recent rise in food and gas prices has us all a little concerned. Still, I ask that you prayerfully consider giving what you can with trust in our Father in heaven. For your on-going generosity to the poor (and to our parish week over week!), I am deeply grateful.

I pray your Lent is off to a good start. Remember that all those penitential practices (increased prayer, fasting, self-denial, giving to the poor, attendance at daily Mass and Stations of the Cross) are all meant to open your heart more to the love of our heavenly Father. I pray your hearts will open fully and expand joyfully with His grace!
