### Great Things Happening at Saint Rose!

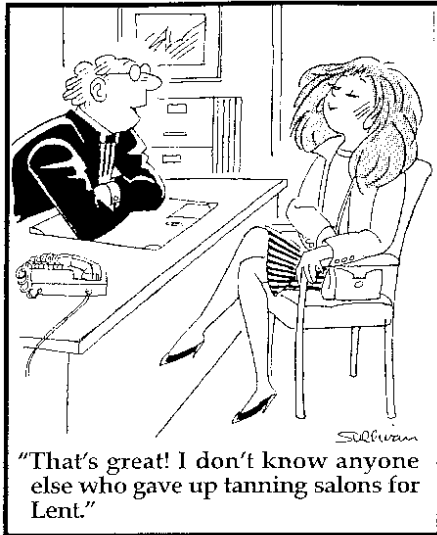
