What a powerful Mission we had this past week! With wit and wisdom, Fr. Menezes brought us deeply into the mystery of God's Divine Mercy and helped us open our hearts more to our Heavenly Father's love for us. I pray that the many graces of our Mission will continue to bless all the people of our parish. Your presence in such wonderful numbers was a testimony to your faith and the faith of our parish. May the Holy Spirit keep us firmly united in faith, hope and charity!

A special word of thanks to Mrs. Patricia Trivisonno who was instrumental in arranging our Parish Mission. Fr. Menezes is a popular preacher who is difficult to book. Pat's hard work and determination made our mission possible. Thank you, Pat!!

Today we enter the holiest week in the Church's year. Catholics throughout the world are encouraged to take the time to reflect on the events that brought us salvation. Jesus gave his very life that we might have life to the full. Is there any gift we have received or will receive that is more valuable? *"God so loved the world that he sent His only Son, so that all who believe in Him might not perish but might have eternal life."* (John 3:16) How can we not stop, pray and thank God our Father for saving us in Jesus?!

Here at SS. Rose & Clement we will solemnly remember each event. On Holy Thursday, we gather at 7:00 PM (there is no morning Mass) to commemorate the institution of the Priesthood and the Eucharist. Jesus, knowing he was to be crucified, ordains his first priests, washes their feet as an example of what they are to do for others and gives to them, and through them to us, the greatest gift on earth—his body, blood, soul and divinity in the Eucharist. Twelve men from our parish, representing the twelve apostles, will have their feet washed during Mass. Following Holy Communion, we will process through the Church with the Eucharist and keep a vigil of prayer until midnight. All are encouraged "to spend one hour" with the Lord.

On Good Friday, Holy Mass is not celebrated. Instead we gather at 3:00 PM to pray the Stations of the Cross at the moment Jesus died and at 7:00 PM to read the Passion from John's Gospel, pray for the needs of the world, venerate the cross and receive Holy Communion.

On Holy Saturday, we gather at 7:00 PM to celebrate the first Mass of the Resurrection. During the glorious Easter Vigil we will sing and celebrate with boundless joy! On Easter Sunday we will celebrate Mass at 8:00 AM and 10:30 AM. There is NO 5:00 PM Mass.

I hope you can join us for some or all of these beautiful liturgies. You will be changed by the immeasurable graces given during these holiest of days. May you have a blessed Holy Week.
