Our Gift Shop will be open all three days of First Communion practice this week.

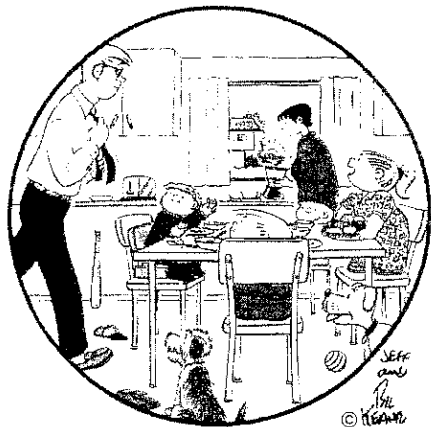
MEN of ST. JOSEPH
