Dear Parishioners,

Several weeks ago I came across a list of ten practical steps for wives and mothers that will lead to greater peace and love in their lives and homes. On this Mother's Day weekend, I thought I would share this insightful list with you:

1. **Develop an intimate relationship with Jesus.** He is our primary love. Allow Him to guide you, forgive you, heal you and fill you.
2. **Keep your priorities in order.** Jesus, first; your husband, second; your children, third; your family and friends, fourth. Lose this order, and trouble is sure to follow.
3. **Realize you are the "heart" of the home.** Love is a woman's great strength and the fulfillment of every human heart. Strive to nurture love in your home.
4. **Trust your instincts.** Women have special insights that should be shared with their husbands. Together you should discuss these and take any needed action.
5. **Pray with your husband.** This may be uncomfortable at first—but work at it! Your marriage bond has the power to bless you, your family and others. Pray together for a strengthening of that bond.

8. **Live a simple, humble life.** Don't give your children too much—and watch what they see and hear. Keep TV to a minimum and let the Saints be their true heroes.
9. **Help your children find their vocation.** God has a beautiful, perfect plan for your children. Help them to find it.
10. **Keep Holy the Lord's Day.** With your husband and children, attend Mass together every week. Make Sunday a day of family togetherness.

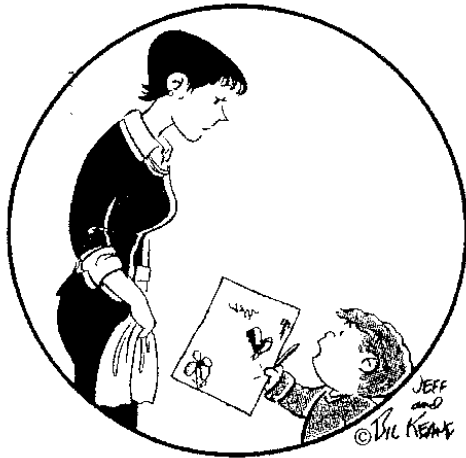
