Dear Parishioners,

The joy of giving starts with God Himself. All we have and all we are is a gift given by God. Reflect on how you give of your time, talent and treasure to our parish and consider what more you can do. Take a leap of faith and get more involved. Don't be afraid! We have many wonderful committees in our parish and many wonderful people on those committees. Join us in our mission to renew the face of the earth through our Catholic stewardship. You won't regret what you give, even for a moment!
