*Dear Parishioners,*

Today we celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi (now called the Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood Christ). The Catechism of the Catholic Church points out 7 effects of the Eucharist in the lives of all who receive regularly and with an open heart:

- 1) *The Eucharist brings intimate union with Christ.* This union with our Savior pierces our soul and fills it with heavenly grace. We don't often appreciate what this means. Heaven comes into our hearts in every Eucharist. This can be painful since the Eucharist challenges us to reject our sins. But this pain leads to interior joys that are beyond this world.
- 2) *The Eucharist separates us from sin.* The Eucharist strengthens charity within us (which is weakened in daily life) and protects us from future sins. The more we receive the Eucharist, the more we want to avoid sin.
- 3) *The Eucharist unites us with the Mystical Body of Christ (the Church).* Despite all our differences, the Eucharist unites every person into the family of God. This union is deeper than any human blood relationship for Jesus himself unites us by his own precious blood.
- 4) *The Eucharist commits us to the poor.* We must always remember that Jesus was born into poverty, lived in poverty and died in poverty. This was his choice! The Eucharist reminds us that we have an obligation to care for those less fortunate—and to lead simple lives ourselves.
- 5) *The Eucharist fills us with zeal to preach the Gospel.* Jesus is the fullness of truth, love and beauty. The more we experience this, the more we want to share Jesus with others.
- 6) *The Eucharist prepares us for death.* At the end of our lives we need nothing but Jesus to carry us across the waters of death to everlasting life. The Eucharist keeps bringing to our minds that this world is passing away and nothing will remain except Jesus. It helps us to keep our life in perspective by keeping our death before our eyes each day.
- 7) *The Eucharist is the promise of the glory to come.* St. Ignatius of Antioch called the Eucharist the "medicine of immortality" for the Eucharist draws us into God's everlasting life and love

We can never receive the Eucharist enough!! I pray every day that all our parishioners receive the Eucharist weekly and more if possible. Nothing is more important, or more fulfilling. God bless you in the week ahead.
