*Dear Parishioners,*

Congratulations to the Eighth Grade Class at St. Rose of Lima School who graduate this Sunday. While we are sad to see them leave, we send them to high school knowing they are well-prepared for the next chapter in their lives. My prayer is that they keep Jesus at the center of their lives (especially the Eucharist, which we honor today on this Feast of Corpus Christi)! I ask you to make that your prayer as well today.

This Friday we celebrate the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. It is an amazing and comforting truth that Jesus has a heart just like us; and his heart experienced the joy of love, the pain of loss, the sorrow of disappointment and the agony of betrayal. He understands what it means to be human. Yet his heart is infinite—an ocean of love that cannot be overcome or exhausted. We are invited into that heart to find strength and refreshment in our own lives. St. Margaret Mary once wrote, “The divine heart is an abyss of all good into which the poor must plunge their necessities. It is an abyss into which we must cast all our sorrows. It is an abyss of humiliation for our pride, an abyss of mercy for the miserable and an abyss of love into which we must cast all our troubles.”

St. Margaret Mary was visited by Jesus and was given a list of promises to all those devoted to His Sacred Heart—the most famous being the promise of final Confession and Holy Communion to all who attend Mass and receive Holy Communion on the First Fridays of nine consecutive months. Our bulletin board in the main lobby of the church has a list of all the promises—please take a moment to read through them.

Immediately following the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, we celebrate the feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. In honoring Mary’s heart we ask her to help us love Jesus as much as she did. Imagine if we loved Jesus as completely as Mary did—we would be saints right now! May the Heart of Mary help us all to love the Sacred Heart of Jesus more and more.

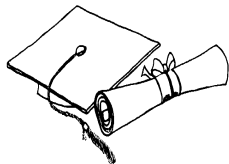
