Dear Parishioners,

On Mother's Day, I shared a list of ten practical steps for wives and mothers that will lead to greater peace and love in their lives and homes. On this Father's Day weekend, I offer ten more for our husbands and fathers:

1. **Develop a personal relationship with Jesus.** Ask him to forgive you, heal you and guide you. Jesus will make you a better man if you let him into your heart.
2. **Get your priorities in order.** Jesus, first; your wife, second; your children, third; your work, fourth. Lose this order, and trouble will follow.
3. **Realize you are the "priest" of the home.** It's your duty to protect your family from every evil influence. Stand firmly for what is right and ask God's strength and wisdom DAILY. Your family needs you!
4. **Educate your children in the moral virtues.** You and your wife are the PRIMARY educators of your children. Do not allow your children to be exposed to objectionable subjects or materials at school or anywhere else (TV, movies, music, video games, etc.).
5. **Pray with your wife.** This may be uncomfortable at first—but work at it! Prayer will help you to reverence your wife and love her as Christ loves the Church.
6. **Spend time with your children.** The power of a father's love is underestimated. Children need it for their full and proper development. Discipline with firmness and love. Your children need to learn boundaries and realize that evil truly exists in the world.
7. **Encourage your family to pray together.** A true father always points his family to God our Heavenly Father. Without Him, we will falter in our sins and weaknesses. If you love your family, YOU will lead them to God!
8. **Do not let sports or outside activities fill your time.** While sports are good, they have become a false god today. Spend time at home and do various activities with your family.
9. **Help your children find their vocation.** God has a beautiful, perfect plan for your children. Help them to find it.
10. **Keep Holy the Lord's Day.** Attend Mass with your family every week and go to Confession often. Do all in your power to help your family become holy. This is what God the Father asks of you.
