Dear Parishioners,

The Church draws her life from the Eucharist. The body, blood, soul and divinity of Jesus Christ present in the Eucharist is the beginning and end of our life. But the glory of Jesus present in the Eucharist is veiled from our eyes until our death, when its full truth will be revealed. So what can we do to keep our faith in the Eucharist strong? I offer you three thoughts:

1. Have a deep devotion to God the Father. Jesus' death on the cross was offered to God the Father. Every Mass is directed to God the Father. It is God the Father's will we seek to live each day. The greater our awareness of God the Father, the greater our love will be for His Son, Jesus, present in the Eucharist.
2. Stop and reflect on what is happening at every Mass. The Mass is the greatest mystery on earth. Through the words of a priest, we are literally brought to the foot of the cross at Calvary 2,000 years ago. We stand with our Blessed Mother and St. John and witness Jesus offering his life for us to God the Father. Then at Communion, we are brought to the Wedding Banquet of the Risen Lamb of God in heaven. It's miraculous—almost unbelievable. But if God can create this universe, and become one with us in Jesus, He can certainly accomplish the miracles found in the Mass and the Eucharist.
3. Seek the help of Our Lady, Woman of the Eucharist. Our Blessed Mother Mary enables us to be united in the deepest way with Jesus in his Eucharistic presence. Since she is perfectly united with Christ, she is the perfect model for us. Mary is present at every Mass and is willing and able to help us grow deeply united to Jesus. Draw close to Mary, and you will grow deeply, madly in love with the Eucharist.

The Eucharist is the key to our happiness. This is the teaching of our Church—and it is the witness of EVERY saint. The more we participate in and love the Eucharist, the happier and more peaceful we will be. May we love the Mass with all our hearts and never miss it for anything in this world.
