We welcome to our parish this weekend Sister Ellen Anderson of the Missionary Sisters of the Holy Rosary for the annual Mission Appeal. The Missionary Sisters of the Holy Rosary were founded in 1924 to educate women in West Africa and to raise the dignity of all African women. Today, the Sisters continue to respond to the awful poverty in Africa, attending to refugees and victims of famine and AIDS (especially women and children) in Biafra, Somalia, Sudan, Rwanda, Sierra Leone, Guinea & Mozambique. Please keep the Sisters in your prayers and give as your means allow to their missionary work among the desperately poor. Thank you!

The negotiations for the repair of the failing concrete continue. This week I am having core samples drilled from the concrete and then analyzed in order to determine just what happened. These tests are very expensive (\$5,397), but will provide needed bargaining power with the sub-contractors. Please keep me in your prayers as I seek to replace the failed concrete at no cost to our parish.

Although I couldn’t attend the concert due to a death in my family, I heard it was exceptional. I enjoy classical music very much (especially chamber music) and look forward to welcoming back “Music on the Hill” next year.

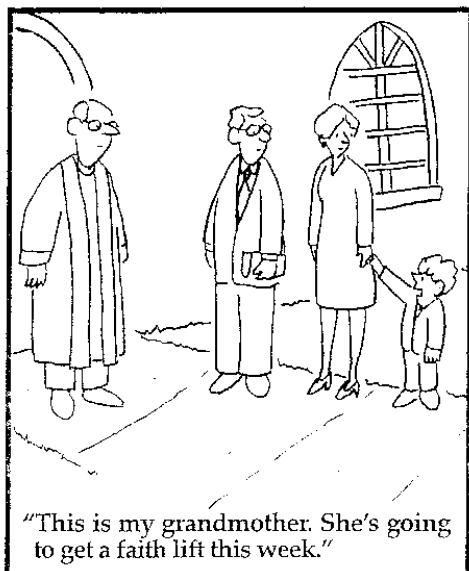
