On April 16, 2008, Pope Benedict XVI spoke these words to the American people during his visit to the US: "Freedom is not only a gift, but also a summons to personal responsibility. In reflecting on the spiritual victory of freedom over totalitarianism in his native Poland and in eastern Europe, he reminded us that history shows, time and again, that "in a world without truth, freedom loses its foundation", and a democracy without values can lose its very soul."

Good food for thought as we celebrate our 235<sup>th</sup> Independence Day. May God bless America and keep her true to her founding principles!

### **MEN of ST. JOSEPH**

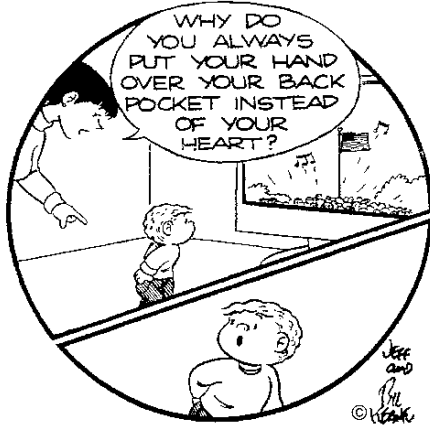
