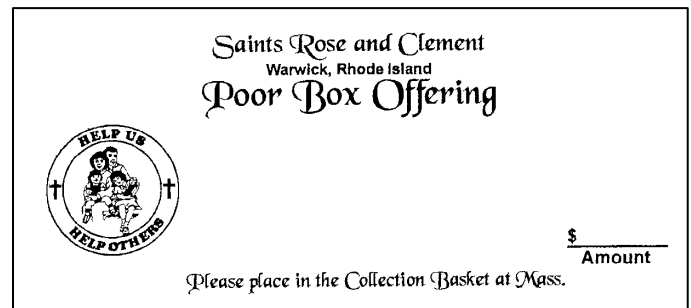

*Dear Parishioners,*

For a few years now I have thought about installing “Poor Boxes” at the entrances to our church. Many parishes have these poor boxes which allow people the opportunity to make a donation each week to the needy. However, after speaking with several pastors, I’ve learned that there’s been an increase in vandalism and theft from these boxes. Since these boxes are expensive to repair (as is damage to the church), I’ve decided to take a different path.

Since the majority of us receive a budget envelope pack every other month, I decided to add one additional envelope for the poor. This gives us all an opportunity once every two months to make a donation of whatever amount which I will use to help the needy among us.



Additionally, I am establishing a new parish fund which will be named the “Mother Teresa Fund” (after Blessed Mother Teresa of Calcutta) in which I will deposit all monies for the poor and from which I will make all disbursements to the poor. Our “Mother Teresa Fund” will bring hope to many needy people. May Blessed Mother Teresa watch over it and make it overflow.

In the Catechism of the Catholic Church #2462 we read “Giving alms to the poor is a witness to fraternal charity: it is also a work of justice pleasing to God.” Thank you for your wonderful generosity to the needy among us—and thank you for your support of our “Mother Teresa Fund” through our new envelope or in any donation you may offer during the course of the year. God bless you in the week ahead.

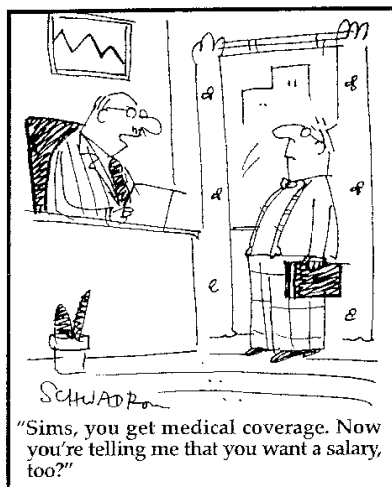
