Last week all the pastors of our diocese received a letter from Bishop Tobin asking for our help with a Summer Food Drive. The current economic condition in our state has driven more and more people to local food pantries and many are very low on supplies. To make matters worse, July and August are typically a time when donations fall off. Bishop Tobin has asked us to ask our parishioners to make a special effort during July and August to collect food.

Here at SS. Rose & Clement I am inspired each week as people quietly slip bags of food into our blue bins on the right side of the main foyer of the church. Tony DiSaia takes these donations each week to St. Rita's Food Pantry and West Bay Community Action—and each week I receive thank you notes from both. May I echo their thanks for your generosity! At the same time, I would like to ask everyone to make a special effort during these summer months to bring in food and fill-up our blue bins. I am told the following are the most needed items: canned tuna, peanut butter, canned beans, canned soups & stews, nutritious breakfast cereals, whole wheat pasta, brown rice, canned fruits & vegetables, juices and tomato sauce. On behalf of those most in need among us, thank you!!

This weekend and next weekend there will be sign-ups for our annual Eight Month Club. This club has a long history of helping our school keep our tuition costs reasonable. Would you please join up and help out our school children? The cost is \$80 (\$10 per month for 8 months). Additionally, I am pleased to announce that the Eight Month Club Dinner/Dance will be held at the Quidnessett Country Club this year! The Quidnessett CC is a beautiful spot and I know the Dinner/Dance will be wonderful. I hope you will join us!
