Dear Parishioners,

In an article on successful parishes, Paul Wilkes writes that successful parishes are built on successful parishioners. True enough. But what makes a successful parishioner? He goes on to offer what he believes are the seven secrets of successful parishioners:

- 1) *They believe in the adventure of being Catholic.* While they do their best to be faithful, they are not afraid to risk, to innovate, to ask questions, to get involved, to evangelize. They LOVE being Catholic and sharing the Good News.
- 2) *They believe in other parishioners.* They look and see untapped talent in their brothers and sisters and invite them to share their gifts. They trust that each person in his or her own way adds something special to a parish.
- 3) *They see the parish as the spiritual epicenter of their life.* They don't spend every waking moment in the parish but they see the parish as central to their life—and the best place to be recharged and refreshed.
- 4) *They do not always have to win or be right.* A parish is a family—and the wisdom of the family must often prevail over an individual's passionate desires. While they may not agree with every decision, they work for the good of the whole community.
- 5) *They are proud enough of their parish to represent it well.* Without being boastful, they speak willingly and happily about their parish's accomplishments, presence in the community and future plans.
- 6) *They are not members, but disciples.* They do not attend Mass or volunteer out of obligation but out of love for Jesus and the Church. They want others to join in the adventure of being Catholic.
- 7) *They believe in the power of prayer and the Eucharist.* This is the foundation of their life: intimacy with Jesus. They know well their sins and weaknesses, and trust that Jesus alone makes all things new! It is His life in them that sustains and drives them to live the Gospel each day.

I see so much of this in you! And it is why our parish is so warm, inviting and full of life! Thank you for your amazing love of our faith and our parish! Many, many people are blessed by Jesus through you!! God bless you in the week ahead.
