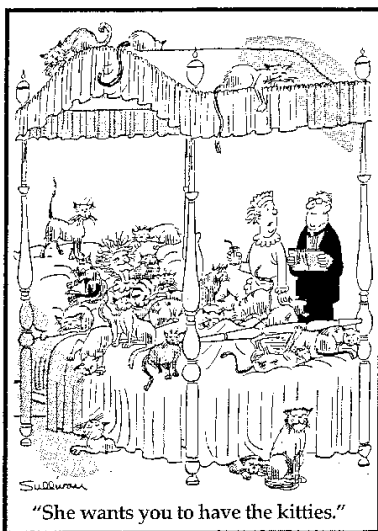
## Providence College
