September 11th remains a day of great pain and sorrow for me as it does for so many of you. Having worked in Manhattan for seven years before entering the seminary, I personally knew several people who died in the terrorist attacks on the World Trade Center. They were wonderful women and men, full of life and love, with whom I had the privilege to work and socialize for years. Hardly a day goes by that I don't think of them and miss them terribly. Yet as a Catholic I am reminded of the words in The Book of Ecclesiastes, "There is a time to be born, and a time to die." We must all pass from this world to the nextsome sooner than others. My prayer is that when we do, we will all be ready-with hearts open to Jesus and the new life he longs to give us. Until that moment, let us mark this day with special prayers for the victims of 9/11 and their families and for all who have lost their lives in the War on Terrorism which followed 9/11 and their families. Much has been lost these ten years. But Jesus' promise of Resurrection is greater than all the losses. May we feel the hope and comfort of that promise in a special way this day.
