

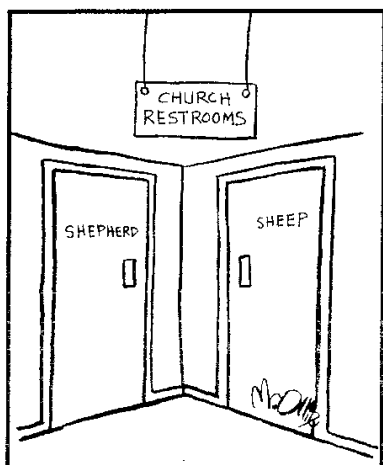
## **“SHARE THE SPIRIT” GIFT SHOP**
