Dear Parishioners,

There is something wonderful about to happen in our Diocese thanks to Bishop Tobin. As you know, the most pressing issue in our Catholic Church today is the large number of people who rarely or no longer attend weekly Mass. As a parish, we've been praying for over a year for their return through our Prayer for Evangelization—and with great success! Our common prayer and your personal invitation have brought many back home.

This December, the Diocese will begin a media blitz on prime-time television (both local and cable) with some beautiful and very moving 60 second interviews with Catholics who have drifted away from Mass and the Church. Each person tells why he or she finally returned. These accounts will bring you to tears.

The campaign is called "Catholics Come Home". You can get a sneak preview by logging in to www.catholicscomehome.org. Please take a look.

As you can imagine, this campaign is very expensive: about \$150,000 to buy prime-time advertising. But God has seen to the cost through an anonymous donor. He wants his children to come home—especially to the Eucharist!

In preparation for this campaign, there will be an Evangelization Congress at Providence College on October 10th. Each parish will send two representatives who will hear several talks on ways to prepare our parishes for this campaign (which will begin in Advent). I have asked our deacon candidates, Mr. John Fulton and Mr. Kenneth Andrade, to represent us. While our parish is more than ready to welcome home our wandering brothers and sisters, it never hurts to look at new ideas and share success stories. Please pray that this campaign will be an enormous success for our Diocese as it has already been in other Dioceses in our country.

This Tuesday, October devotions (Rosary & Benediction) begin at 7:00 PM in the church. Please join us (eat quickly and don't turn on that television) as we honor our Blessed Mother. The closer we are to Mary, the safer we are in every storm we face.

Next weekend, a second collection will be taken to benefit the Seminarian Education Fund. This Fund supports the education of the young men who are studying to become priests for our Diocese. The vaccine is **FREE** for those who are insured by Blue Cross/Blue Shield, Medicare Part B and UnitedHealthcare. The co-pay is \$15.00 for all other insurance companies. If you don't have health insurance, the cost is \$25.00 for the flu vaccine.

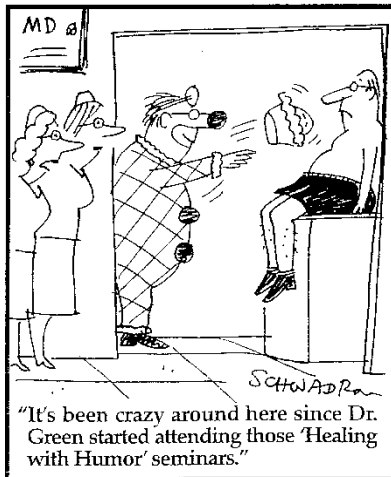
