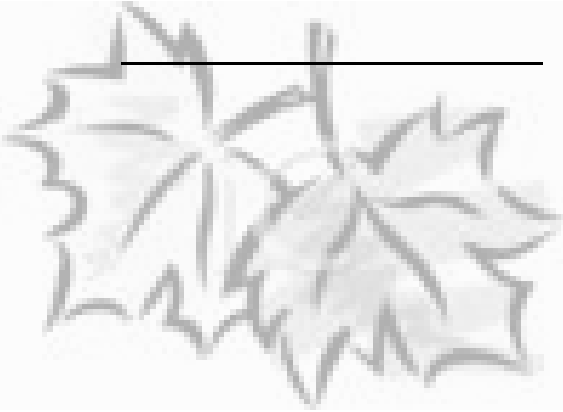

WOMEN'S FAITH ENRICHMENT GROUP

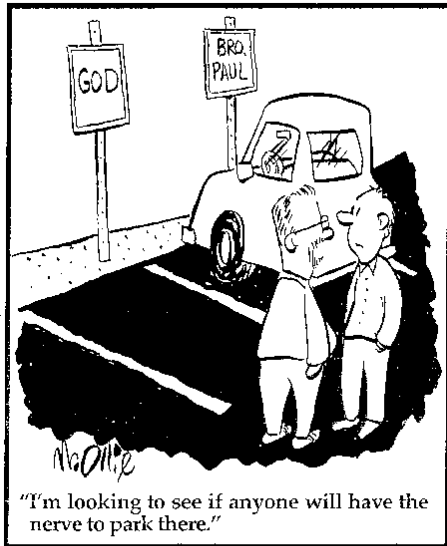
