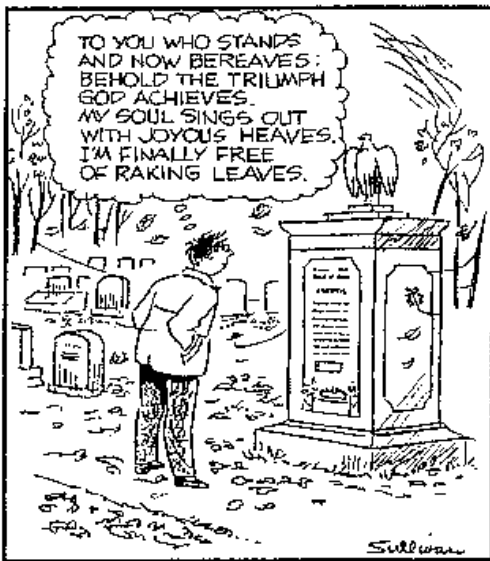
“SHARE THE SPIRIT” GIFT SHOP
