*Dear Parishioners,*

Recently I read a very interesting article that addressed this question, “Is it gossip to unload news and concerns about co-workers, friends and family with my spouse—or is this a legitimate way to seek comfort and input?” The article goes on to say that it is natural for spouses to let off steam with each other, but they must be careful not to fall into idle gossip. The authors (a married couple) went on to list six questions you should ask yourself before you share with your spouse:

1. *Does the matter involve me personally?* If the news isn’t about you, keep it to yourself.
2. *What is my motivation for sharing this information?* If you’re just looking to wallow in anger or make another look bad, keep it to yourself. If you’re looking for a solution, ask your spouse’s advice.
3. *What effect will my conversation have on my spouse’s perception of the person?* Don’t ruin your spouse’s perception of another—nobody is all bad. If you seek advice for a problem, be sure to point out the good in that person as well.
4. *If the tables were turned, would I want this information shared about me?* The Golden Rule always applies.
5. *Might sharing this information help protect others from harm?* If another’s actions have caused harm or may cause harm, speaking about it to defend others is legitimate.
6. *If the topic is legitimate to speak about, are we careful to limit it only to each other?* Helping each other out as a sounding board is fine, as long as the conversation goes no further. Don’t pass it on—and be sure to have the conversation privately and out of earshot of any children.

It think that’s good advice—I hope you agree.
