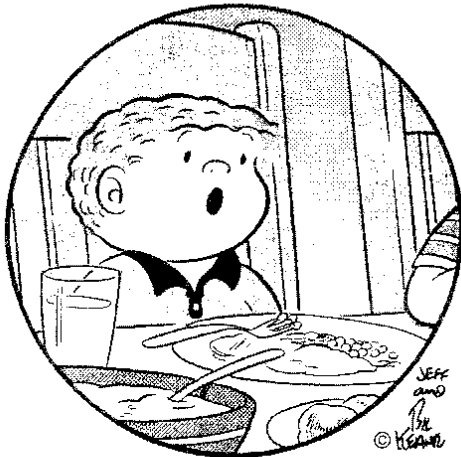
Next week we begin the season of Advent. **Are you prepared?** If you are in need of candles, wreaths, and calendars, we have them on display in the Gift Shop foyer.
