Dear Parishioners,

Well it's that time again—time for New Year's Resolutions. Here are ten that I believe will strengthen your spiritual life in 2014 (5 this week, and 5 next week)—I pray you will take to heart one or more of them:

- 1. Find a Patron Saint: If you don't have a patron saint, it's time to find one! Saints are our heroes and are powerful intercessors for us in heaven. You might want to learn more about the saint you were named after, your Confirmation saint, the patron saint of your profession or hobby or any saint who interests you.
- 2. Attend Daily Mass: Most parishes offer daily Mass during the week in the morning, evening or during lunch. Most daily Masses will only take about 30 minutes of your day. In return, you'll receive powerful graces and blessings.
- 3. Go to Confession Monthly: Yes, it's difficult to face your sins and say them out loud, but frequent reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation gives you the grace to fight those sins and perhaps finally defeat them.
- 4. Read the Bible: If you don't own a Catholic Bible, invest in one and keep it out where you will see it every day. Read a short selection from the New Testament daily.
- 5. Get involved with your parish: There are multiple committees and activities in your parish that need your input and help. Make new friends and help spread the Good News by giving some of your time.

I hope those will help to get your New Year off to a great spiritual start!
